







Greenest building in Europe

- The Enterprise Centre was formed as a result of the Adapt Group's involvement in the construction sector;
- UK's first commercial low carbon building targeting highest BREEAM and *Passivhaus standards*;
- Class leading standards for 'embodied carbon';
- One of the most sustainable buildings in Europe.


