



#### **Some Stats**




18,200 - All students within the 45 RIBA accredited School of Architecture (from RIBA report on 2017/18 data)






## My Personal Experience

- Renewed certification, 2016 after the completion of the Carrowbreck Meadow Development at Hamson Barron Smith (required every 5 yrs)





















# Hamson Barron Smith Experience
